BUYER USER ROLES BASED ON SEGREGATION OF DUTIES







BUYER

Buyer & Consignee can be the same entity. Makes purchases and draft BILLS



CONSIGNEE

Accepts & Rejects consignment.
Also generates CRAC



Selects the item and add it in specific buyer's cart



PRIMARY USER

Scope of Primary User:

- 1. Register Organization
- 2. Creation / Modification of Secondary Users
- 3. Manage users and Deactivation
 - 4. Monitoring of Orders placed

The Primary user registration is authorized at the level of Deputy Secretary/ Equivalent officer or Head of the Officers at Sub Centre/ Unit/ Branch of Government Organization/ PSU/ Autonomous Bodies / Local Bodies / Constitution Bodies / Statutory Bodies.

Processes bills and pushes bills to PFMS



Pay and Accounts Office Process bills for payment (Non PFMS Payment mode)



TECHNICAL EVALUATOR

Evaluates bidders on technical parameters



Pre-requisites for Primary User Registration

Aadhar Number of the User



Email IDs hosted by NIC (Users from 1600+ domains)*



Mobile Number linked with Aadhar.



Verifying authority details such as name, mobile numbe and NIC registered Email ID.

^{*} In case the user does not have an email id which is hosted by NIC s/he would be directed to open GeM Buyer ID email account.

Secondary User registration:

Aadhaar Number / Virtual ID of the User.

Active Mobile number to which your Aadhaar is linked – for OTP purpose.

NIC registered Email ID/ gembuyer.in.

Note: In case the user does not have an Email ID which is hosted by NIC s/he would be directed to open GeM buyer ID email.

Verify primary user details using your Aadhar and linked mobile no



Complete registration and login details for primary user account



Complete primary user profile by adding your organizational and verifying authority details .



Primary user adds details of the secondary user



Secondary User to sign up and complete verification



Secondary User to update their Profile.

- At the time of Registration, the Primary user needs to provide the Verification Authority, the details such as First Name, Last Name, Official Email address, and mobile number under the Referral Verification Section.
- If the Verification Authority does not click on the deactivation link within 48 hours, the Primary user is considered auto-approved for GeM.
 - An email is then sent to the Competent Authority with the information about approval.
